Ok, so what we have here is twelve bands (some from Poland, among others) - MOLOCH LETALIS, OFFENCE, RIOTOR, RAGEHAMMER, STILLBORN, AXECUTOR, WARFIST, HATE THEM ALL, PAGANFIRE, EXCIDIUM, EMPHERIS, WHIPSTRIKER and twelve songs of alcohol-fuelled thrash, originally executed by GEHENNAH from Sweden. GEHENNAH was the band consisting of some death metal dudes back in the mid-90s (like VOMITORY, DAWN OF DECAY, to name but a few). GEHENNAH's music is good, catchy old-school metal...the featured bands did a real good job interpreting Swedes' songs from various albums; yeah, no doubt this sort of underground music is best re-enacted by other underground, dedicated crews. I must say I love OFFENCE's Bang your Heads for Satan best. Of course, other participants did well too, no complaints. What I also like about this release is the layout, the booklet, a really nice and thick one with plenty of "stylish" photos.
