

This is a five-track, self-released, limited, red vinyl 7`` ep by JAD from Warsaw. The content was recorded in January 2020 at the Lazy Sound Studio (at which their full-length album was recorded as well, btw). The recording and mix were performed by Grzegorz and Marcin Kucharski.

That's about the technical details. The A side features three tracks with eloquently sounding names: Pętla (Hangman Noose), Wstręt (Repulsion) and Zwykła Śmierć (Ordinary Death). The B side consists of Agresja (Aggression) and Spalona Ziemia (Scorched Earth). The last song perfectly describes what is left of us after we are done playing this ep. Indeed, this JAD band does pay homage to the old punk/crust tradition from the mid 80s, very well.
